A WHOLE PERSON THERAPEUTIC PROGRAM

We focus on the whole person at HOH:
Body, Soul and Spirit.

SAFE FACILITY IN A HOME-LIKE ENVIRONMENT

We are a Maximum Watchful Oversight,
Child Caring Institute specializing in
therapeutic care for CSEC victims in the
State of Georgia.

STATE LICENSED, FAITH-BASED. TRAUMA-INFORMED

We are located in the beautiful
Golden Isles on the coast of Georgia
- the only program of this kind in our
region. Each girl in residence is
provided with her own private and
beautifully decorated suite.

STRENGTHS-BASED DISCIPLINARY APPROACH

Our residents experience a 3:8 ratio during
daylight hours of caring adults trained in CSEC
recovery and can earn rewards for making good
choices - like excursions in our beautiful coastal
area.

AN EDUCATIONAL PLAN THAT EMPOWERS SUCCESS

Residents are under constant supervision and do not have
access to the Internet

ONLINE ACCREDITED CURRICULUM

Our residents attend school in the home
enjoying an accredited program and
guided by our Education Coach.

PARENTING CLASS

We employ Parenting Reality Works
Program at HOH. Each resident receives a
"baby" for 2 weeks to care for within the
12-week program.

SPIRITUAL DIRECTION

Residents attend Bible Study and Church
weekly as part of spiritual direction and
development.

ORIGINAL CSEC CURRICULUM

Both staff and residents receive training created and
developed by HOH.

INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PLANS

Each resident's needs are assessed and her education
plan is tailor-made to fit her needs and help her reach her
goals.

INDEPENDENT LIVING PROGRAM

HOH offers an in-house ILP program and will open a CSEC ILP
Program to provide continuity of care for young women ages
18+ in Spring 2021.

IN-HOUSE HEALTH EDUCATION & CARE

HOH employs a Nurse Practitioner who creates an
individualized health care plan for each resident and also
teaches a weekly health education class.

A THERAPEUTIC PROGRAM SET APART FROM THE REST

TRAUMA-INFORMED THERAPY

Includes: daily group therapy, 2 individual
therapy sessions weekly, Boundaries
training (16-week course)

CSEC SPECIFIC RECOVERY

Children victimized by human sex trafficking
share a specific and terrible trauma. House
of Hope is 1 of only 3 homes currently
open to provide shelter and recovery to
minor CSEC females in GA.

ADDICTION PREVENTION & RECOVERY CLASSES

UNIQUE THERAPEUTIC MODALITIES

Includes: Art Therapy, CBT, DBT,
Neurofeedback/Neurotherapy, and EMDR
